Summer 2017 Camper Application

Lethbridge Girls Rock Camp (LGRC) is a not-for-profit, volunteer-driven organization that provides girls the opportunity to learn a new instrument (or new techniques on an old one) and express themselves in creative and artistic ways. Through our partnerships (YWCA of Lethbridge and District, CKXU 88.3 FM, Blueprint), we provide an environment that builds confidence, leadership, and teamwork skills.

**2017 Camp Dates: July 24th to 28th (9am to 4pm),
and July 29th (Showcase, 5pm to 8pm)**

Camper Requirements:

Campers must be between the ages of 8* and 17 at the time of the camp.

*7 year olds entering Grade 3 in September are also welcome to apply

Campers do not need to have any prior music experience!

The Showcase component is mandatory:

campers who are unable to attend the Showcase should not register for the camp.

Registration: At LGRC, camp fills on a “first-come, first-registered” basis. We strongly recommend that you submit your application as soon as possible. You can mail your application to the address listed above or drop it off at Blueprint (same address) during store hours. All applications are timestamped, whether completed electronically or in physical form. If you’d prefer to use the newfangled online form, please check our website for the link. If camp fills up, we will contact you to discuss your options (being added to the waitlist or switching instruments).

Camp Fees: Our camp fee (tuition) is \$200. This fee includes lunches, snacks, use of equipment, and one ticket to the Showcase (campers are already on the guest list).

Don’t worry about sending camp fees with your application: we will notify you once you have secured a spot and send instructions about paying camp fees at that time.

***Please note: LGRC firmly believes that money should never be a barrier to attending camp, therefore, subsidies are available [find out more information in Section 5 – Camp Fees (Tuition)]. LGRC can also work with you to create a payment schedule to meet your needs.

Location: All parts of the camp, including the Showcase, will take place at The Gate located at 522 – 3rd Avenue South (downtown, just south of Galt Gardens).

On Monday morning, the campers form bands. These are the bands the campers will write a song with during the week and play with at the Showcase on Saturday night. If you are interested in forming a band with your friends who are also attending camp, please let us know below. We will do our best to accommodate requests, but please understand that we also need to ensure a balance in instrumentation.

4. Media Permissions:

During Camp and at the Showcase, LGRC will make audio and visual recordings. These recordings are only ever used to promote LGRC or our member organization, the Girls Rock Camp Alliance (GRCA). When we do sell anything related to camp (eg. songs on our Bandcamp page), the money goes directly back into camp. If you secure a space at camp, your camper information package will include a media release form with options for you to choose from should you have any concerns around safety / media exposure.

5. Camp Fees (Tuition):

Lethbridge Girls Rock Camp is a not-for-profit organization, which means we run entirely on volunteer time / energy and through donations collected during fundraising efforts. For this reason, your camper’s tuition is an important part of ensuring that the camp is running each summer. The price of the camp was decided after reviewing what other camps in the area were charging for the same time frame and similar services.
