Summer 2019 Intern Application Lethbridge Girls Rock Camp (LGRC) is a not-for-profit, volunteer-driven organization that provides girls (transgender / cisgender) and non-binary youth the opportunity to learn a new instrument (or new techniques on an old one) and express themselves in creative and artistic ways.

Through our partnerships (YWCA of Lethbridge and District, CKXU 88.3 FM, Making Connections, Street Legal), we provide an environment that builds confidence, leadership, and teamwork skills.

2019 Camp Dates: July 8th to 12th (9am to 4pm), and July 13th (Showcase, 5pm to 8pm)

Intern Requirements:

Interns must be between the ages of 14* and 17 at the time of the camp.

*13-year-olds entering Grade Nine in September are also welcome to apply
Interns do not need to have any prior music experience!

The Showcase component is mandatory:
Interns who are unable to attend the Showcase should not register for the camp.

Registration: At LGRC, camp fills on a "first-come, first-registered" basis. We strongly recommend that you submit your application as soon as possible. You can mail your application to the address listed above or drop it off at Street Legal (same address) during store hours. If you'd prefer to use the online form, please check our website (lethbridgegirlsrockcamp.com/camper/registration-form). All applications are timestamped, whether completed electronically or in physical form. If camp fills up, we will contact you to discuss your options (being added to the waitlist or switching positions).

Camp Fees: Our camp fee (tuition) is \$200. This fee includes lunches, snacks, use of equipment, and one ticket to the Showcase (Interns are already on the guest list).

Don't worry about sending camp fees with your application: we will notify you once you have secured a spot and send instructions about paying camp fees at that time.

***Please note: LGRC firmly believes that money should never be a barrier to attending camp, therefore, subsidies are available [find out more information in Section 4 – Camp Fees (Tuition)]. LGRC can also work with you to create a payment schedule to meet your needs.

Location: All parts of the camp, including the Showcase, will take place at The Gate located at 522 – 3rd Avenue South (downtown, just south of Galt Gardens).
